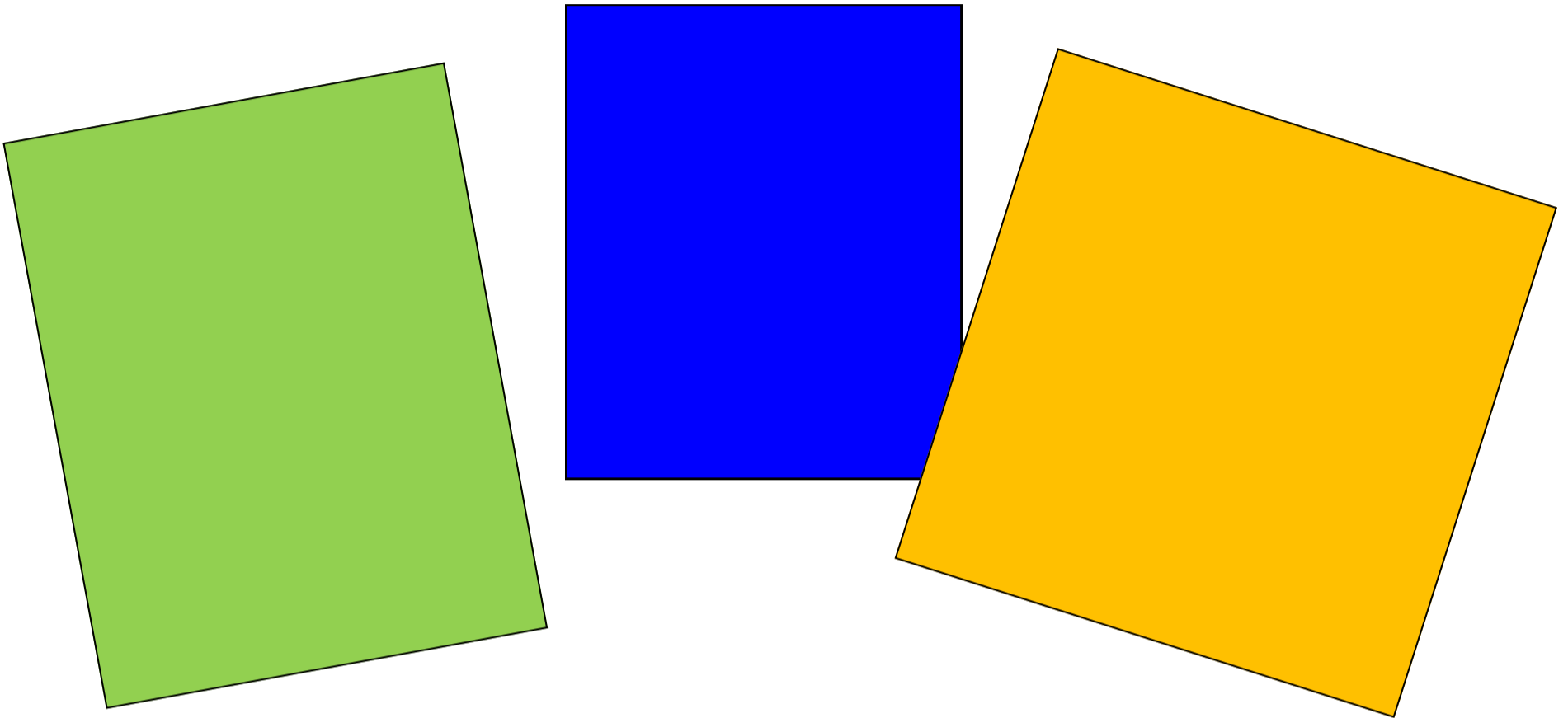


Paper Station



Test Your UV Beads With Colored Paper!

- ◆ Put your ultraviolet beads in a dark place—like your closed fist or a pocket. Wait a minute or so.
- ◆ Put your beads under a sheet of colored paper.
(Try to keep the beads out of the Sun while you are slipping the beads under the paper).
- ◆ What do you see?
- ◆ How do you explain what is happening to the beads?



Fabrics Station

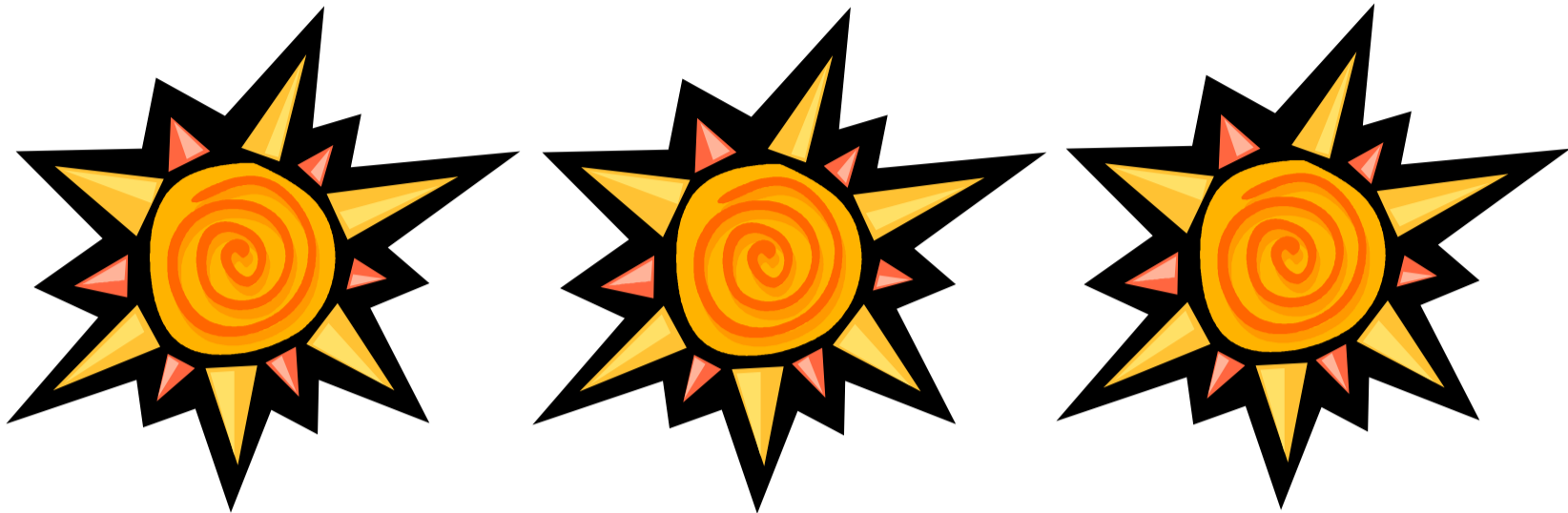


Test Your UV Beads with Fabrics!

- ◆ Put your ultraviolet beads in a dark place—like your closed fist or a pocket. Wait a minute or so.
- ◆ Place your bead under different kinds of fabric and watch what happens to your UV beads.
- ◆ What do you see?
- ◆ How do you explain what is happening to the beads?



Sun Station



Test Your UV Beads in the Sun!

- ◆ Put your ultraviolet beads in a dark place—like your closed fist or a pocket. Wait a minute or so.
- ◆ Place your beads in a bright and sunny spot and watch what happens to your UV beads.
- ◆ What do you see?
- ◆ How do you explain what is happening to the beads?



Shade Station



Test Your UV beads in the Shade!

- ◆ Put your ultraviolet beads in a dark place—like your closed fist or a pocket. Wait a minute or so.
- ◆ Find a shady spot—look for as much shade as you can! This time place your beads in the shade and watch what happens.
- ◆ What do you see?
- ◆ How do you explain what is happening to the beads?



Sunglasses Station



Test Your UV Beads with Sunglasses!

- ◆ Put your ultraviolet beads in a dark place—like your closed fist or a pocket. Wait a minute or so.
- ◆ Place a bead into your cupped hand and cover them with one of the lenses of your sunglasses. Watch what happens to your UV beads.
- ◆ What do you see?
- ◆ How do you explain what is happening to the beads?



Sunscreen Station



Test Your UV Beads with Sunscreen!

- ◆ Take a look at the beads in the baggies with sunscreen.
- ◆ One has a **LOW** sun protection factor.
- ◆ One has a **HIGH** sun protection factor.
- ◆ Which sunscreen prevents the beads from turning color? Is one do you think is better for your skin?
- ◆ How do you explain what is happening to the beads?



Water Station



Test Your UV Beads in Water!

- ◆ Put your ultraviolet beads in a dark place—like your closed fist or a pocket. Wait a minute or so.
- ◆ Dip your bead into the container of water and watch what happens to your UV beads.
- ◆ What do you see?
- ◆ How do you explain what is happening to the beads?
